## E-LEARNING

### What is E-Learning?

E-learning is a style of distance learning. The coursework is provided via our e-learning website, which is split into the different modules of your chosen qualification. ## E-LEARNING CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE CONTINUED

The qualification covers a broad range of construction hazards and the means by which they can be controlled. It includes the main legal requirements relating to construction work and enables students to undertake effective safety inspections on a construction site.

This NVQ level 3 qualification meets the academic requirements for Technician Membership (Tech IOSH) of Institution of Occupational Safety and Health and Associate membership (AIIRSM) of the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management.

Those who have passed the Nebosh General Certificate Management paper (NGC1) or the National Diploma in H&S within the last five years only have to sit the NCC1 & NCC2 elements of the course.

Please note although you can study online the examinations must be taken with a approved course provider such as Cambridge Safety and these cannot be taken online. Fees are only payable for the examinations and assessments when you register for these.

## E-LEARNING ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATE

This course is designed for all those who have involvement in environmental issues within the organisation. This is an NVQ level three qualification covering 9 different areas of environmental practice. The course assessment includes a two hour examination set by NEBOSH along with a workplace based environmental audit and report.

Environmental standards are developing rapidly in the UK with more and more regulations covering issues such as waste management, energy efficiency and pollution control. Managing environmental issues is not only a legal necessity but can result in definite improvements and cost savings if implemented successfully.

Guidance will be given on completing the workplace environmental audit and report writing skills. The completion of the audit in the delegate's own workplace allows the course to have a direct impact on identifying areas of improvement for that workplace.

## E-LEARNING

### Optional Tutorials, Revision and Exam Preparation Sessions

Additional tutorial days on specific topics, for a maximum of 4 days, are available, places permitting. Please ask for our current course agenda for dates and topics.

Revision tutorials are run prior to most examinations, these aim to cover a range of issues from the relevant syllabus, focus on examination techniques and give candidates an opportunity to do a variety of practice examination type questions. It also enables delegates to clarify any points from the syllabus which they are unsure about. Time permitting a mock assessment or examination is also used to prepare candidates for their formal examinations.

### Sitting the Examinations

Study may commence at any time and you have the flexibility of choosing when to sit your examinations. However please note that to enter for any Nebosh exam or assessment, exam registration must be made approximately 10 weeks before the examination date, for example if the exam date is the 10th of June, candidates must register with their examination centre by the 15th of April. Details of the exam dates and registration dates are provided once you have booked on, or if you have a specific exam date in mind please contact us to confirm when you will need to be registered. Exams for certificate level qualifications are available at least four times a year. We shall contact you if you have not made contact with us regarding your study for a period of 6 months.

## E-LEARNING NEBOSH GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY CERTIFICATE

The certificate is designed to help non safety specialists meet their health and safety obligations although many safety practitioners start with this course before progressing to the more intensive and detailed NEBOSH Diploma. This intensive yet informative course covers the NGC1: Safety Management, GC2: Workplace Hazards and GC3: the Practical Assessment. There are two written examinations, both of two hours and one work based assessment to be completed to obtain the qualification. Please note although you can study online the examinations must be taken with an approved course provider such as Cambridge Safety and these cannot be taken online.

- Health and Safety Foundations and legal overview
- Health and Safety Management – Plan

### GC2 Controlling Workplace Hazards

- Movement of people - including work at height.

- Physical and physiological hazards - including noise, vibration, stress, violence and radiation

### Outline Programme

The course elements begin with the legal background to H&S, with both common and statute law explored. From here the concepts of accidents, hazard, risk and risk assessment are examined. We suggest you study the NGC1 first and then the workplace hazards from the GC2 but you can study at your own pace and have the flexibility to study topics in any order.

## E-LEARNING CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate is aimed at Supervisors, Managers, Estates and Facilities managers, all those involved in the selection of contractors, as well as construction managers. The course is aimed at those within the construction industry who are required to ensure that activities under their control are undertaken safely. It is likely to prove useful for those concerned with the management of buildings who may need to ensure that contractors are working safely.

The qualification is assessed via two written examinations, both of two hours, along with one assessed workplace inspection. This course is particularly important as it enables organisations to meet their obligations under the Construction, Design and Management Regulations 2015. It can assist in demonstrating competence to undertake the role of the Client, Principle Designer, Principle Contractor, Contractor or Designer.

The course consists of three units NGC1: Management of health and safety, this is common to both the General and Construction certificate, NCC1: Managing and controlling hazards in construction activities and NCC2: Workplace inspection and report. There are two examinations and a workplace inspection to be completed to gain the qualification.

- Movement of construction vehicles
- Manual and mechanical handling on site
- Work equipment, Electricity hazards and control & Fire
- Chemicals and biological hazards
- Physical and psychological hazards
- Working at height
