This intensive yet informative course is run over **five days days** with the one 90 minute multiple choice examination to be taken on the fifth day. Our course covers the four elements of the qualification and has time set aside for mock assessments and revision before the end assessment. The course is run on a day release basis to suit the needs of both student and employer but can also be run in-house if you have a number of delegates who need training.

The course is highly participative with tutor presentations supported by the use of practical exercises, syndicate and group work, video and feedback sessions.

The Nebosh HSE certificate in Process Safety Management is the perfect qualification for those who need to understand the principles of process safety management. By studying this qualification you will be able to contribute to the effective management of process safety and be able to profile the major risks presented.

This is a highly intensive training programme which covers a wide variety of subjects. Delegates are expected to complete revision questions outside the tutorials.

When things go wrong in the process industry the results can be catastrophic. This has been evidenced by incidents in the past which have led to loss of life and many billions of US dollars' worth of damages. The Deepwater Horizon incident which tragically led to 11 people losing their lives and the total cost to BP was in the region of \$62

billion. The process safety industry is high hazard so having qualified people to manage activities within the industry will lead to safer workplaces. This will help to prevent loss of life but will also help to protect valuable assets and help organisations avoid prosecution and ultimately loss of reputation.

Who is the course designed for?

Employees and the self employed who work in process industries such as oil and gas, chemicals, plastics and pharmaceuticals. These industries have a number of inherent risks which need to be managed as there are significant risks which arise if a problem or accident were to occur. This qualification has been designed and developed by Nebosh and the Health and Safety Executive to give process safety knowledge and understanding to managers, supervisors and health & safety professionals to allow them to manage their process safety responsibilities.

However please note this this qualification is not designed for process safety/chemical engineers with extensive operational experience of working within the processing environment.

This qualification sits along side the other health and safety and environmental qualifications established by Nebosh to assist organisations to manage risks effectively and meet their various legal obligations.

- Management of process risk
- Process safety hazard control
- Fire and explosion protection

Venues

All courses are run in our training centre in Swan Court, Hampton, Peterborough which is easily accessed from the A1, A47 and the local parkway system. There is adequate provision for car parking as we also have access to an extra secure car parking facility within 5 minutes of our centre.

Course fees

The course fees include four days of tutorials, a half day revision session, all examination and marking fees, course book, buffet lunch and refreshments each day.

Bookings

It is a condition of booking that the fee is payable in advance. A cheque or order requisition should be sent with the course booking form. An invoice will be raised as required. Full joining instructions will be sent to delegates approximately 2 weeks before the course commences.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in writing and are subject to the following charges: £50 admin fee per booking; plus if 8 - 28 days notice are given 50% of the course fees and any exam fees pre-paid to Nebosh; No refunds will be made within 1 week of the course start date but you may send a substitute delegate provided their application can be accepted by the tutor and there is still time to register with NEBOSH for the examination. Once a course has started no refunds or substitutions are possible.
