

## NEBOSH CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate is aimed at Supervisors, Managers, Estates and Facilities managers, all those involved in the selection of contractors, as well as construction managers. The course is aimed at those within the construction industry who are required to ensure that activities under their control are undertaken safely. It is likely to prove useful for those concerned with the management of buildings who may need to ensure that contractors are working safely.

The qualification is also appropriate for supervisors and managers working in other industries and work functions such as facilities and estates management. The course is now assessed via one online open book examination (**OBE**) covering the management of health and safety, one two hour traditional examination and one assessed workplace inspection. This course is particularly important as it enables organisations to meet their obligations under the Approved Code of Practice which forms part of the Construction, Design and Management Regulations 2015. It can assist in demonstrating competence to undertake the role of the Client, Principle Designer, Principle Contractor, Contractor or Designer.

The course consists of three units NGC1: Management of health and safety, NCC1: Managing and controlling hazards in construction activities and NCC2: Workplace inspection and report.

The course is run on a day release basis to suit the needs of both student and employer. External delegates are accepted for examination packages.

The course is highly participative with tutor presentations supported by the use of practical exercises, syndicate and group work, DVD and feedback sessions. Our **pass rates on all our Nebosh programmes** consistently exceed the national average.

We also provide a complimentary set of the Construction Site Safety GE 700 publication. This is a highly intensive training programme which covers a wide variety of subjects. Delegates are expected to complete revision questions and exercises outside the tutorials.

As well as tackling the extensive syllabus and standards set by Nebosh, the course will also give assistance and practical guidance on the end assessments.

The **NCC2** workplace inspection will allow delegates access to a construction site where they can develop their practical skills and become familiar with the standards expected by NEBOSH.

The course covers a broad range of construction hazards and the means by which they can be controlled. It includes the main legal requirements relating to construction work and enables students to undertake effective safety inspections on a construction site.

This NVQ level 3 qualification meets the academic requirements for Technician Membership (Tech IOSH) of Institution of Occupational Safety and Health and Associate membership (AIRSM) of the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management.

Those who have passed the Management paper (NGC1) or the National Diploma in H&S within the last five years only have to sit the NCC1 & NCC2 elements of the course. Contact us for further details of eligibility.

### Training Venue

### Bookings

It is a condition of booking that the fee is payable in advance. A cheque or order requisition should be sent with the course booking form. An invoice will be raised as required. Full joining instructions will be sent to delegates approximately 2 weeks before the course commences.

### Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in writing and are subject to the following charges: £50 admin fee per booking; plus if 8 - 28 days notice are given 50% of the course fees and any exam fees pre-paid to Nebosh; No refunds will be made within 1 week of the course start date but you may send a substitute delegate provided their application can be accepted by the tutor and there is still time to register with NEBOSH for the examination. Once a course has started no refunds or substitutions are possible.
