


NEBOSH Diploma In Environmental Management



In 2017 the brand new Nebosh Environmental Diploma was launched, there has been an extensive consultation between Nebosh and organisations, individuals along with both national and international stakeholders to determine the content and format of its new environmental qualification. This will be a qualification for both UK employers and those companies who operate overseas.

The structure and course elements have been updated and completely revised and there is a brand new format for the practical project as well.

We at Cambridge Safety have deliberately delayed running another Environmental diploma until the format and structure of the syllabus was approved.

The taught course includes tutorials, online resources and the completion of work based projects. In total sixteen days of study will be required to cover the entire syllabus.

This is one of the few professional courses available in environmental management, it is aimed primarily at safety practitioners, who either have responsibility for environmental management or those whose role interlinks with that of the environmental manager. Holders of this qualification may use the designatory letters EnvDipNEBOSH after their name. IOSH CPD Participants may allocate CPD credits for attendance at this course.

In addition holders of the Environmental Diploma are eligible for Associate Membership of IIRSM, and those achieving the qualification meet the requirements for non-chartered Member (MCIWEM) of the Chartered Institution of Water and Environmental Management (CIWEM) for holders achieving the overall qualification from 1 February 2009 onwards. They are also now eligible to become practitioners of IEMA.

Assessment is via one 3 hour examination where delegate have a choice of 5 from 8 questions, and a work based project which is based on the production of an environmental audit. Tutorial support is provided for the end of course examination and the work based assignment (NDEM2).

The course is highly interactive, with many syndicate exercises and individual activities, including visits to sites of interest to environmental practitioners. In addition to the tutorial sessions, delegates are expected to carry out at least 100 hours of directed private study, some of this time has been planned into to the course to enable a more flexible approach to study.

Many employers give responsibility for environmental management to the organisation's safety advisor or manager. Holding the Nebosh diploma will provide the holder with the confidence to undertake their role, as well as being an indicator of the competence inside and external to the organisation.

This course includes tailor made presentations, presentation slides, handouts, e-learning, delegate only resources, podcasts, self marked assessments, tutor marked assessments and online resources.

Venue

Courses are held in our own training centre in Hampton, Peterborough. Car parking is available on-site plus there is street parking nearby and we have access to a further secure car park nearby.

Course fees

Full Diploma £2900 + vat plus Nebosh fees £195
Nebosh fees (Registration and ED1 = £108, NDEM2 = £76)

A 10% discount is offered if a second delegate from the same organisation is booked on the same course. The course fees include all assessment and marking fees, comprehensive course notes, lunch and refreshments each day.

Bookings

It is a condition of booking that the fee is payable in advance. A cheque or order requisition should be sent with the course booking form. An invoice will be raised as required. Once payment has been received a pre course questionnaire and receipt will be issued. Full joining instructions will be sent to delegates approximately 4 weeks before the course commences. Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in writing and are subject to the following charges: £50 admin fee per booking; plus if 8 - 28 days notice are given, 50% of the course fees and any exam fees pre-paid to Nebosh; No refunds will be made within 1 week of the course start date but you may send a substitute delegate provided their application can be accepted by the tutor and there is still time to register with NEBOSH for the examination. Once a course has started no refunds or substitutions are possible.
