

## NEBOSH Fire Safety Certificate

Fire is a chemical reaction, it is a hazard and risk which can have an adverse effect on any business. Poor management of fire safety can impact on all businesses and all areas of its activities, whether it is a hospital, factory or office. The best managed organisations ensure that health and safety and fire safety standards are part of every job role rather than being the remit of the company health and safety advisor or fire advisor. Those with responsibilities include all managers, employees, directors as well as those with specific responsibilities such as fire wardens and first aiders. Often fire issues may conflict with other business goals and objectives. For instance if employees store trolleys in front of a fire exit rather than in the designated area because this is closer.

The Brand New NEBOSH Fire Safety Certificate 2021 is designed for people who have fire safety responsibilities at work. It provides the knowledge and understanding, when combined with relevant experience, to carry out an effective fire risk assessment, as well as embed good practice in the workplace.

Holders of this accredited qualification help their organisation to ensure it meets its fire safety responsibilities. Fire safety is important. It protects people from injury and loss of life. It protects your property, your assets and your investment ensuring employees know how to help their employers avoid the damaging and sometimes catastrophic losses that result from fire.

The course is highly participative with tutor presentations supported by the use of practical exercises, syndicate and group work and feedback sessions. The main piece of legislation which forms a key part of this qualification is the details of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 will be examined and fire related issues developed to enable delegates to complete fire risk assessments in a variety of different workplaces. The qualification is assessed by two brand new style assessments, one open book exam to check your underpinning knowledge and a work based fire risk assessment to enable you to apply your knowledge in a real workplace of your choice.

FSC1 : Open Book Exam accessed online at home, 24 hour access, case study with exam questions

FSC2 : Workplace fire risk assessment to be submitted to Cambridge Safety—full guidance and documents will be provided

#### Venue
