E-LEARNING

What is E-Learning?

E-learning is a style of distance learning. The coursework is provided via our e-learning website, which is split into the different modules of your chosen qualification. E-learning is a more interactive style of studying as you will progress through a series of slides with exercises, video clips and handouts, allowing you to study at your own pace.

What does the E-Learning package include?

Once payment has been received, we will send you an introduction pack via email including background information on the qualification, study plan, how to access the e-learning material and how to submit end of element reviews. We will also provide you with information on how to register for the exams, and exam technique guidance. You will be given unique log-in details to the e-learning website, access to the web site is for one year.


You will have access to:

- Introduction to the qualification
- Study techniques guidance
- Presentations for all elements on the syllabus, including the NEBOSH e-learning outcomes, quizzes, interactive exercises and handouts
- Video presentations via YouTube
- Useful forms and documents in PDF or word format
- An interactive A-Z of key terms
- Podcasts which can be downloaded or streamed to your phone or tablet
- Downloadable printable course handouts and additional downloadable resources to support your chosen qualification
- Guidance on the completion of the practical element of your selected qualification (if applicable)

Support and Feedback

The interactive presentations include a number of quizzes and questions, these can be completed more than once and the answers are given once completed. At the conclusion of each element a set of review questions will be provided to be completed and sent back to us for marking and feedback.

Support will be provided for a period of twelve months, this includes queries by telephone or email Monday to Friday. We will mark and provide feedback on your work within 4 working days and endeavour to answer your query immediately but if this is not possible you will receive a response within 4 working days.

Cooling off period and Cancellation Terms

We are confident that you will learn a lot using the variety of learning materials provided however, as you booked online rather than visiting us in person, you have a mandatory 14 day cooling off period under the Consumer Contracts (Information, Cancellation and Additional Charges) Regulations 2013.

If you wish to cancel your package you will need to contact us in writing or via email (info@cambridgesafety.co.uk) with evidence to show this was done e.g. recorded delivery letter or email receipt.

If you do this, on receipt of your request, we will cancel your online access and order and arrange for a refund of your payment. If you have not logged in and utilised any of the online material your payment will be refunded in full.


However, please note that if you have logged in onto the website you will have waived your right to the 14 day cooling off period and no refunds will be offered.

If you have purchased a hard copy set of handouts, these will need to be returned in an unused and new condition, via Royal Mail signed for which you will be responsible for the postage and packaging costs, to be sent within the 14 day period.

If you submit any course work to be marked, this will be marked after the 14 day cooling off period.

We regret that cancellations of e-Learning material (irrespective of logging onto the website) cannot be made after this 14-day period and refunds after this date will not be provided. However, within one year of your e-Learning start date you can transfer to the classroom version of your chosen qualification with us if one is available. With your e-Learner fees being transferred you would just pay the balance between the classroom course and e-learner price plus a £50 + vat transfer fee.

Once delegates are registered for their Nebosh assessment, refunds are not available for the Nebosh fees as Nebosh do not routinely provide refunds.

Bookings (but not payment) can be made directly through our web site at www.cambridgesafety.co.uk. Assessment dates available will be provided with your joining pack. Assessments & Examinations must be booked and paid for at least 6 weeks prior to examination date.

All course material is provided for personal use and must not be copied or stored electronically in any way without the permission of the Partners of Cambridge Safety LLP. Support for certificate packages is available for a period of 12 months after the package is ordered and payment is received. Open Book Examinations must be registered through our centre in Peterborough.

E-learning packages are supplied to the named individual who makes the booking and cannot be transferred to anyone else. If we detect multiple log-ins we reserve the right to stop access. Access to the e-learning website is for one year, commencing from when the log-in details are issued.

Revision

A Revision pack is sent to you when you register for your examinations within the 12 month tutor support period (or can be purchased if your support has expired). This typically includes mock exam style questions, key terms, true or false questions, with answer schemes, video presentations and the opportunity to send in your work for marking and feedback—this must be sent to us at least 7 working days prior to the exam date.

Sitting the Examinations

Study may commence at any time and you have the flexibility of choosing when to sit your examinations. However please note that to enter for any Neboosh exam or assessment, exam registration must be made approximately 6 weeks before the examination date, so you need to plan ahead to ensure you have enough time to study prior to your selected exam date.

Details of exam and registration dates are provided once you have booked on, or if you have a specific exam date in mind please contact us to confirm when you will need to be registered. Exams and assessments for certificate level qualifications are normally available at least four times a year.

To ensure you are progressing with your study we shall contact you if you have not made contact with us regarding your study for a period of 6 months.

Please note although you can study online, the assessments must be taken with an approved Learning Partner such as Cambridge Safety and these must be booked in advance.

E-LEARNING NEBOSH GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY CERTIFICATE

The General Certificate is designed to help non health & safety specialists meet their health and safety obligations - many safety practitioners start with this course before progressing to the more intensive and detailed National Diploma. This qualification consists of eleven course elements, four covering the management of health and safety and seven covering specific workplace hazards and risks. The four management elements are assessed by one open book examination which can be taken in a safe and suitable location of your choice.


The more practical workplace hazards and risks are assessed via a comprehensive workplace risk assessment report. The NG1 is the name given to the management of health and safety and open book exam assessment. With the NG2 being the name given to the workplace hazards section of the qualification. Both open book exam and risk assessment have to be passed in a five year period to achieve the qualification. We recommend allowing approximately 100 hours of study time.

We will provide you with downloadable handouts, end of element reviews so you can track your progress plus there are podcasts and YouTube videos which can be watched covering a majority of the different topics within the syllabus. You will be provided with everything you need and will not need to buy any other books or study material.

E-LEARNING NEBOSH FIRE SAFETY CERTIFICATE

The new syllabus NEBOSH Certificate in Fire Safety is launched in March 2021 and is designed for people who have fire safety responsibilities at work. It provides the knowledge and understanding, when combined with relevant experience, to carry out an effective fire risk assessment, as well as embed good practice in the workplace.

Holders of this accredited qualification help their organisation to ensure it meets its fire safety responsibilities. Fire safety is important. It protects people from injury and loss of life. It protects your property, your assets and your investment ensuring employees know how to help their employers avoid the damaging and sometimes catastrophic losses that result from fire.

The main piece of legislation which forms a key part of this qualification is the details of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 will be examined and fire related issues developed to enable delegates to complete fire risk assessments in a variety of different workplaces.

As well as tackling the extensive syllabus and standards set by Nebosh, the course will also give assistance and practical guidance on examination techniques and full guidance on the completion of the FSC2 workplace fire risk assessment will be provided.

E-LEARNING ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATE

This course is designed for all those who have involvement in environmental issues within the organisation. This is an VRQ level three qualification covering 9 different areas of environmental practice.

Environmental standards are developing rapidly in the UK with more and more regulations covering issues such as waste management, energy efficiency and pollution control. Managing environmental issues is not only a legal necessity but can result in definite improvements and cost savings if implemented successfully.

Guidance will be given on completing the workplace environmental aspect and impact assessment which forms part of the end assessment. The completion of the assessment in the delegate's own workplace allows the course to have a direct impact on identifying areas of improvement for that workplace.

Many employers give responsibility for environmental management to the organisation's safety advisor or manager. Holding the new Nebosh Environmental Certificate will provide the holder with the confidence to undertake their role, as well as being an indicator of the competence both internally and externally to the organisation.

E-LEARNING CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

The new syllabus NEBOSH H&S Management for Construction Certificate is launched March 2021 and is aimed at Supervisors, Managers, Estates and Facilities managers, all those involved in the selection of contractors, as well as construction managers.

This qualification is particularly important as it enables organisations to meet their obligations under the Construction, Design and Management Regulations 2015. It can assist in demonstrating competence to undertake the role of the Client, Principle Designer, Principle Contractor, Contractor or Designer. The construction certificate is assessed via one open book exam, accessed online at home over 48 hours.

The first three elements cover management of health and safety based around CDM 2015, and the other ten units cover the range of construction hazards with control measures

- Foundations of Construction H&S and Management
- Improving H&S culture and assessing risk
- Managing change and procedures
- Excavation
- Demolition
- Mobile plant and vehicles
- Working at Height
- Musculoskeletal health and load handling
- Work equipment
- Electricity
- Fire
- Chemicals and biological agents
- Physical and psychological health

The qualification covers a broad range of construction hazards and the means by which they can be controlled. It includes the main legal requirements relating to construction work and enables students to undertake effective safety inspections on a construction site.
